\*\*A non-competitive race license is required for all non-USA Cycling members. The license costs \$5.00. Insurance is included in the race fee.

## Race Location:

Lake Reba/Camp Catalpa Park, Richmond, KY

Directions: Take exit 90 A off of I-75. Travel on the Robert R. Martin Bypass approx. 4 miles. Take a left onto Gibson Bay Dr. This street becomes the main entrance to the park. Once inside the park, follow the roads bearing to the left until you locate the shelter adjacent to the marina/boat launch. This will be the area for registration and race starts. - All registration is day-of-race. There is no early registration, and no late fee.
- **Helmets and eye protection are required for all riders.** Unsafe bicycles will not be allowed on the course during the races.
- No bar ends allowed on mountain bikes or hybrids.
- Vehicles may be present on short sections of roadway during the race. Racers should be cautious on and around roads.
- Please stay on marked course when in the park. We want to be invited back!
